- **Grades 3-6**: The WNGBC's goal is to elevate each player's potential by encouraging them at the skill level they're at.

 Tryouts are an opportunity for coaches to evaluate players' current skill level & fundamental understanding of the game.

 No "cuts" are made in these grades. Rather, placement into the level that will enable each girl to grow as a team player.

TEAMS

- All student athletes will participate at their current grade level.
- The WNGBC hopes to have enough interest to create two teams at each grade level. If this occurs:

 - 3rd & 4th Grade: teams will be divided equally. 5th, 6th, 7th, & 8th Grade: an "A" (Purple) and a "B" (White) team will be formed, based on the Tryouts evaluations.
 - Splits are dictated by the League structure

COVID-19 RELEASE

Due to the pandemic, a return-to-play clearance form must be completed by the parent/guardian/caregiver of every studentathlete in order to participate in any athletic activities in connection with The School District of Waukesha (SDW).

 - NOTE: Balance Payment will not be processed if season is cancelled before Jan 01, 2021.
- Contactless payments are setup & accepted online through TeamSnap during the Registration process.
- Offline payments (cash/check) will not be accepted.

SHOOTING SHIRTS • UNIFORMS • SPIRIT WEAR

- Jersey Number Selection
 - All players must submit their requested Jersey Numbers whether or not a new Uniform is needed.

 - Jersey Number Selection deadline is Oct 18, 2020 (Sun). **3rd Grade: Nov 12, 2020 (Thurs)
 - Players with new Uniforms must submit three choices for requested Jersey Number.
 - TIP: American basketball leagues at all levels traditionally use digits between 0 & 5.

(i.e. 00, 01–05, 10–15, 20–25, 30–35, 40–45, and 50–55)

NCAA and most amateur competitions mandate that only these numbers be used. This eases non-verbal communication between referees, who use fingers to denote a player's number, and the official scorer.

EXPECTATIONS

The Jr. Northstars Girls Basketball Program is designed to provide basketball skill development through practices and games in preparation for high school basketball at Waukesha North. Parents/families are expected to make the commitment to have their child at all practices and games throughout the season. Parents should communicate effectively with their daughter's coaches related to any absences due to illness or other circumstances for each missed practice and/or game. Player and Parent Code of Conduct sheets must be signed before the season and adhered to throughout. These deal with attitude and actions while playing or being a fan. All families are required to fullfill a 4 hour per player minimum time commitment to help volunteer during our fundraising events.

FACILITIES

Practice facilities in the School District of Waukesha are difficult to secure due to high demand by multiple organizations. To ensure that our club maintains our positive relationship with the schools we use for practice, parents and siblings are asked stay in the gym based on the individual coaches rules. Absolutely no playing in the halls, balconies, stairs, or other sections of the schools or playing with equipment that does not belong to the Jr. Northstars Girls Basketball Program. We have a permit for the gym only!

The Jr. Northstars Girls Basketball Program will host one tournament called the "Shoot for the Stars" Tournament held in February 2021 - PLEASE SAVE THE DATE. This is an important group which will meet multiple times October through January to plan our annual Tourney. Money raised from this Tournament will be used towards gym time, extra tournaments, special training sessions, practice uniforms, as well as warmup shooting shirts for all grades.
